Oh, and there are plenty of guest appearances as well. There were struggles, triumphs, failures; there were break-ups, make-ups, shake-ups; light and tragedy; humor and inspiration. But, through it all, there was the music, which led us through our misguided youth and into a reluctant adulthood. I was there for the rise and fall of Peter Frampton; the shattering break-up of The Beach Boys; the dogged determination of Bruce Springsteen; and the launch of Tom Petty’s career. I raised hell with Eddie Money, drank with Rod Stewart and Keith Moon, and watched Mick Jagger overtaken by stagefright, and, sadly, lost several close friends.
